## **Ultrasound Seminar & Practical Teaching**

The annual Ultrasound Seminar is planned as a practically orientated seminar with lectures and with hands-on training on Monday - Wednesday. The objective is to provide postgraduate, on the job training in up to date techniques, for m.o., a.m.o. and specialist working in hospital. The training in ultrasound is an excellent example of the practical application of this idea. The workshops will be held in basic abdominal sessions in the morning (pregnant women) and theoretical sessions in the afternoon. Advanced workshops will present more complex techniques for ultrasound-guided procedures as well as tips and tricks. Each workshop will include a theoretical part, case presentations, and hands-on training.

Each registrant will be able to participate in different workshops. In the afternoon there will be time for discussion. *Your accommodation and travel expenses (bus fee) will be refunded (max. 30.000 TSH per day, all in).*
