

Ultrasound Seminar & Practical Teaching Arusha Tanzania

The annual Ultrasound Seminar is planned as a practically Orientated Seminar with lectures on Sunday and with hands-on training on Monday-Wednesday. The objective is to provide postgraduate, on the job training in up to date techniques, for mo's, a.m.o's and specialists working in hospitals. The training in ultrasound is an excellent example of the practical application of this idea. The workshops are divided in groups of beginners (inexperienced) and users (experienced). The workshops will be held in basic abdominal sessions in the morning (pregnant women) and advanced breast sessions in the afternoon. Advanced workshops will present more complex techniques for ultrasound-guided procedures (punctures, ablation) as well as tips and tricks. Each workshop will include a theoretical part, case presentations, and hands-on training. The number of participants is restricted (experienced doctors and fast responders first)

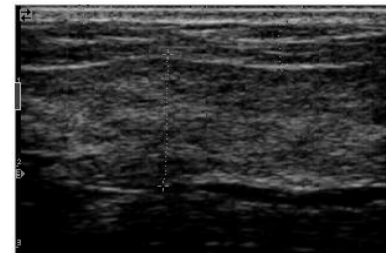
