The annual Ultrasound Seminar is planned as a practically orientated seminar with lectures on Sunday and with hands-on training on monday-wednesday. The objective is to provide postgraduate, on the job training in up to date techniques, for mo's, a.m.o's and specialists working in hospitals.
